

Student Activity-Birds

Today's Activity is to make your own "Rose Bay Bird Field guide". A field guide is a book with different birds for identifying. A Field Guide usually has the name of the bird, a picture, and the scientific name (remember the lecture?). Today we will go around to various bird spots in Rose Bay, and look at the birds through the binoculars. Once we get a good bird in sight, draw it on one of the pages in your booklets. After that, look the bird up in official field guide, by flipping through the pictures, and be sure to write the name of the bird and its scientific name. Next, we will meet up with the other bird group out on the dock for more bird watching. When we are finished making our field guides, we will distribute each student one of Shannon's home made bookmarks. Write your name on the front and share it with your friends! That is our activity for today.
